- Agriculture Development Directorate, Bagamati Province, Hetauda invites electronic bids from eligible bidders for the Construction of Provincial Agriculture Wholesale Market in collaboration with Hetauda Sub-Metropolitan under National Competitive Bidding - Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding procedures Only eligible bidders with the following key qualifications should participate in this bidding:
 - Minimum Average Annual Construction Turnover of the best 3 years within the last 10 years: 176,000,000.00 NRs.
 - Minimum Work experience of similar size and nature: at least One(1) Construction of RCC Framed Building Contracts within the last ten (10) years, with a value of at least NRs 280,000,000.00 that have been successfully or are substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed works.

- The bids will be opened if possible in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 06-12-2020 at 13:00 Hrs at the office of Agriculture Development Directorate, Bagamati Province, Hetauda.
- Bids must be valid for a period of 120 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of NRs, 10,540,000.00, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
- If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
